SEALED BIDS for Parking Garage Stairwells Rehabilitation and other incidental items will be received by the LEXINGTON-FAYETTE URBAN COUNTY AIRPORT BOARD (hereinafter referred to as “LFUCAB”) in the Administration Offices, 2nd Floor Terminal Building, Blue Grass Airport until and not later than 10:00 A.M. Local Time on the 10th day of August, 2021, at which time the Bids will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Terminal Building, Second Floor, Airport Board Conference Room.

THE PROJECT consists of concrete repair, rust removal, painting, stair and tread repair, caulking, and pedestrian traffic coatings in the Parking Garage at Blue Grass Airport.

Following the meeting, prospective bidders will be escorted to the project site. This is a non-mandatory pre-bid meeting, although prospective bidders are strongly encouraged to attend.
